POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Production Supervisor, the incumbent is responsible to operate machines and equipment in accordance with company policies and procedures. The incumbent will work within the guidelines set out in the ISO standard.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibilities of this position are to operate equipment in a safe manner to produce quality parts that meet or exceed the customers requirement.

- Maintaining a clean and safe work area.
- Inspecting parts using methods and frequencies established by the Quality Assurance Department.
- Identifying and isolating parts that do not conform to specification.
- Operating equipment according to established procedures.
- Bar coding information relating to the operation being performed, into the computer system according to procedures.
- Ability to work shifts on a rotating basis
- Communicating critical information to supervisor and oncoming shifts.
- Identify items requiring maintenance and report to supervisor.
- Support, communicate and implement Lean Manufacturing principles into all areas of responsibility.
