POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Welding and Fabrication Supervisor, the incumbent is responsible to operate welding equipment in accordance with company policies and procedures. The incumbent will work within the guidelines set out in the Canadian Welding Bureau and ISO standard the company is registered to.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary responsibilities of this position are to operate equipment in a safe manner to produce quality parts that meet or exceed the customers' requirement.

- Maintaining a clean and safe work area.
- Inspecting parts using methods and frequencies established by the Quality Assurance Department.
- Identifying and isolating parts that do not conform to specification.
- Operating equipment according to established procedures.
- Bar coding information relating to the operation being performed, into the computer system according to procedures.
- Ability to work shifts on a rotating basis
- Communicating critical information to supervisor and oncoming shifts.
- Identify items requiring maintenance and report to supervisor.
- Read and interpret blueprints or welding process specifications.
- Perform welding processes using established CWB procedures.
- Other duties as required.
